This Privacy Policy describes the information BRISKHEAT CORPORATION and its subsidiaries (BRISKHEAT, "us," "we," or "our") collects about you, how we use and share that information, and the privacy choices we offer. Please read the following to learn more about our Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect off-line and through our Website, mobile applications, other online products and services, and various off-line sales and marketing events we conduct and/or sponsor (collectively, the "Services" or "Website") and does not apply to our collection of non-personal information from other sources. BRISKHEAT CORPORATION is committed to protecting personal information you may provide us through our Services.

INFORMATION YOU PROVIDE AND WE COLLECT

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION collects both personal information you provide on this Website, and automatically collected information that does not directly identify you.

1. Personal information includes any information that may be used to specifically identify or contact you, such as your name, mailing address, phone number, email, including information that can identify, relate to, describe, be associated with, or be reasonably capable of being associated with a consumer or household, which may have been received by us when requesting information or technical help, or when registering for certain information, warranty, or events both on- and off-line. When you contact us by telephone, we will collect the information you provide over the telephone. We will also collect information you provide in product registration card submissions.

2. Non-personal information can include certain personal information that has been deidentified. We obtain non-personal information about you from information that you provide us, either separately or together with your personal information. We also automatically collect certain personal information from you when you access our Services, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website. We may also collect information about your computer and internet connection, specifically your IP address, operating system, and browser type. The information we automatically collect is used to estimate our audience size and usage patterns; store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests; speed up your searches; and recognize you when you return to our Website. Data we collect automatically, which may not be personal information, is treated as personal information when it is attached to other personal information. Specific information may include, among other things, IP addresses, the type of browser you are using (e.g., Bing, Safari, Chrome, etc.), the Services from which your visit originated, the operating system you are using, the domain name of your Internet service provider, the search terms you use on our Services, data that tracks the specific web pages you visit, and the duration of your visits.



OTHER USES & INFORMATION

We use your Personal Information to provide you with the services you request as well as for analytical and marketing purposes, such as confirming, sending, and tracking your order or account registration; communicating with you about your order or account registration; analyzing preferences, trends, and statistics; informing you of our new products, services, and offers; and providing you with other information from and about us including personalized marketing communications. Such collection and uses include:

1. IP Addresses: An IP address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer whenever you are surfing the Internet. Web servers (computers that "serve up" web pages) automatically identify your computer by its IP address. When visitors request pages from our Services, our servers typically log their IP addresses. We collect IP addresses for purposes of system administration, to report aggregate information to others, and to track the use of our Services. It is not our practice to link IP addresses to anything personally identifiable; that is, the visitor's session will be logged, but the visitor remains anonymous to us. However, we reserve the right to use IP addresses to identify a visitor when we feel it is necessary to enforce compliance with our Services rules or to: (a) fulfill a government request; (b) conform with the requirements of the law or legal process; (c) protect or defend our legal rights or property, our Services, or other users; or (d) in an emergency to protect the health and safety of our Service users or the general public.

2. Cookies, etc.: "Cookies" are small text files from a website and/or mobile device that are stored on your hard drive and/or other storage device. These text files make using our Services more convenient by, among other things, saving your passwords and preferences for you. We may analyze the information derived from these cookies and other technological tools we employ (such as clear gifs/web beacons) and match this information with data provided by you or another party. We may provide our analysis and certain non-personal information to third parties (who may in turn use this information to provide advertisements tailored to your interests), but this will not involve disclosing any of your personal information. Please note that advertisers that serve advertisements on our Services may also use their own cookies and other technological tools that are subject to the advertiser's privacy policies, not this Privacy Policy.

3. Email Communications: If you send us an email with questions or comments, we may use your personal information to respond to your questions or comments, and we may save your questions or comments for future reference. For security reasons, we do not recommend that you send non-public personal information, such as passwords, social insurance/security numbers, or bank account information, to us by email. However, aside from our reply to such an email, it is not our standard practice to send you email unless: i) you request a particular service or sign up for a feature that involves email communications; ii) it relates to purchases you have made with us (e.g., product updates, customer support, etc.); iii) we are sending you information about our other products and services; or iv) you consented to being contacted by email for a particular purpose. In certain instances, we may provide you with the option to set your preferences for receiving email communications from us; that is, agree to some communications but not others.

DISCLOSURE TO OUTSIDE PARTIES

We do not sell, trade, or transfer your personal information to third parties, except in the circumstances described below.

Our Dealers

We share your personal information with our Dealer network to better serve your specific needs, requests, inquiries, and other customer service communications. We consider this information private and make every attempt to protect and limit how it is used and disclosed. Third Party Service Providers

Legal Requirements and Business Transfers

We may disclose personal information: (i) if we are required to do so by law, legal process, statute, rule, regulation, or professional standard, or to respond to a subpoena, search warrant, or other government official requests; (ii) when we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical harm or financial loss; (iii) in connection with an investigation of a complaint, security threat, or suspected or actual illegal activity; (iv) in connection with an internal audit; or (v) in the event that BRISKHEAT CORPORATION is subject to mergers, acquisitions, joint ventures, sales of assets, reorganizations, divestitures, dissolutions, bankruptcies, liquidations, or other types of business transactions. In these types of transactions, personal information may be shared, sold, or transferred, and it may be used subsequently by a third party.

Cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. YOUR CALIFORNIA AND OTHER STATE PRIVACY RIGHTS (continued)

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION has not sold consumers' personal information in the twelve (12) months preceding the Effective Date of this Privacy Policy. - debug to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality;
- exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise his or her right of free speech, or exercise another right provided for by law;
- comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act pursuant to Chapter 3.6 (commencing with Section 1546) of Title 12 of Part 2 of the Penal Code;
- engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when BRISKHEAT CORPORATION's deletion of the information is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of such research, if you have provided informed consent;
- to enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with BRISKHEAT CORPORATION;
- comply with a legal obligation; or

YOUR EU PRIVACY RIGHTS

Additional information for individuals who submit personal information to our Website from within the European Economic Area ("EEA")

In addition to the aforementioned information, the following information applies to any individual located in the EEA. For the purposes of this section, any defined terms have the meaning under the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and its United Kingdom equivalent ("UK-GDPR"). BRISKHEAT CORPORATION and its corporate affiliates, each in its own capacity, acts as a "Data Controller" under the GDPR. Legal Basis of Processing

In this section, we identify the lawful ground we rely on for processing Personal Data.

Consent

If BRISKHEAT CORPORATION relies on consent for the processing of personal information, we will provide transparent notice of the purposes for which we seek such consent at the time we collect your personal information.

If BRISKHEAT CORPORATION wishes to process any special categories of personal information as set out in Article 9(1) of the GDPR or UK-GDPR, BRISKHEAT CORPORATION may obtain your explicit consent for such processing.

Contractual Necessity

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION processes personal information to fulfill our contracts with our business partners and service providers, such as for rendering payment or communicating with health care professionals or consultants.



YOUR EU PRIVACY RIGHTS (continued)

Legal Obligation

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION may process personal information as specifically required by applicable legal obligations, such as laws and regulations that require BRISKHEAT CORPORATION to process personal information for purposes of obtaining regulatory approvals and making transparency disclosures.

Public Interest

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION may process personal information for scientific or historical research purposes, or statistical purposes in public interest, as authorized by applicable law.

If BRISKHEAT CORPORATION wishes to process any special categories of personal information as set out in Article 9(1) of the GDPR or UK-GDPR, it may do so when necessary for scientific research purposes, medical diagnosis, or the protection of vital interests.

Legitimate Interests

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION may process personal information subject to its own legitimate interests, such as to facilitate treatment; to schedule appointments; to offer support programs; to offer community initiatives; to promote scholarly research; to develop, administer and support research; to operate, evaluate and improve our business; to process donations; to support our recruitment activities; to process job applications; or to facilitate a sale of assets or merger or acquisition.

It may also be necessary for BRISKHEAT CORPORATION to process personal information to establish, exercise or defend against fraud, illegal activity, and claims and other liabilities, including by enforcing the terms of use that govern the services we provide.

Compatible purposes

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION may also process personal information for purposes that are compatible with those described above. Such purposes may include scientific research.

Data Retention

We retain personal information as long as it is necessary to accomplish the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy unless a longer period is required under applicable law or is needed to resolve disputes or protect our legal rights.

The criteria used to determine the period for which personal information about you will be stored varies depending on the legal basis under which we process such personal information:

Consent

For the period of time necessary to fulfill the underlying agreement with you, subject to your right, under certain circumstances, to have certain personal information about you erased (see Data Subject Rights below).

Contractual Necessity

For the duration of the contract plus some additional limited period of time that is necessary to comply with the law or that represents the limitation period for legal claims that could arise from the contractual relationship.

Legal Obligation

For the duration of time that we are legally obligated to keep the information. Public Interest for the period of time necessary to fulfill the purposes of the business process in public interest and for any period of time that may be required to document the public interest or business process under applicable law.

Legitimate Interests

For a reasonable period of time based on the particular interest, taking into account the fundamental interests and the rights and freedoms of the Data Subjects.



YOUR EU PRIVACY RIGHTS (continued)

Legitimate Interests (continued)

We may face any threat of legal claim and in that case, we may need to apply a "legal hold" that retains information beyond our typical retention period. In that case, we will retain the information until the hold is removed, which typically means the claim or threat of claim has been resolved.

Transfer of Personal Data Outside of the EEA

BRISKHEAT CORPORATION processes your personal information in the United States, which does not provide the same level of data protection as the EEA. Where your Personal Data is processed by BRISKHEAT CORPORATION or third parties outside of the EEA, we will ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place to adequately protect your Personal Data, as required by applicable law, if the

recipients are not located in a country with adequate data protection (as determined by the European Commission). Such safeguards may include the execution of standard contractual clauses; the consent of the individual to whom the personal information pertains; or other safeguards permitted by applicable EEA requirements.

GDPR and UK-GDPR Data Subject Rights

Under the GDPR and UK-GDPR, in certain circumstances, an EEA-resident Data Subject has certain individual rights with respect to the personal information that we hold about them. You are entitled, under certain conditions, to obtain personal data related to you in a structured, widely used, machine-readable format and to transfer this data to another controller (data portability). Please send these types of requests to us via GDPR@nibe.se. In particular, you may also have the right to:

- Request access to any data held about you;
- Ask to have inaccurate data amended;
- Request data held about you to be erased, provided the data is not required by BRISKHEAT CORPORATION to perform a contract, protect its rights, interests, or those of a third party, defend against a legal claim or to comply with applicable laws or regulations;
- You are also entitled to object to and request limitation of the processing of your personal data and to request deletion of your personal data.
- Prevent or restrict processing of data which is no longer required; and
- Request transfer of appropriate data to a third party where this is technically feasible.

GDPR and UK-GDPR Data Subject Rights (continued)

Additionally, in the circumstances where you may have provided your consent to the collection, processing, and transfer of your personal information for a specific purpose, you have the right to withdraw your consent for that specific purpose at any time. Once we have received notification that you have withdrawn your consent, we will no longer process your information for the purpose or purposes you originally agreed to, unless we have another legitimate basis for doing so in law.

To exercise any of these rights, please contact us using the contact details set out under the "Contact Us" heading below. As a resident of the EEA, you are also entitled to direct any complaints in relation to our processing of your personal information to your national or local data protection authority (i.e., your Supervisory Authority).

Policy Changes

We reserve the right to update this Privacy Policy at any time. When we update this policy, we will revise the "Effective Date" date above and post it to our Website. If material changes are made, we will place a prominent notice on our Website for at least 30 days prior to the change taking effect, or, for current customers or others with whom we have a business relationship, we will communicate with you directly by email. The new privacy policy will apply to all current and past users of our website and will replace any prior inconsistent privacy policies.
